

850 Qualifier Info

9am – 11am on the 3rd Saturday of the month

No charge, just the standard \$40 range fee.

First and foremost, the qualifier is intended to be informational. It's primarily a safety briefing and range familiarization. However, there is some shooting involved. Participants will engage steel targets (12 in x 20 in silhouettes) at 400, 600 and 850 yards with reasonable accuracy. 100 percent accuracy is not required, just a basic understand of the ballistics and the equipment necessary to make long range shots *safely*. The range officer present for the qualifier is there to help. He will assist with wind calls and adjustments as well as maybe a correction or two with fundamentals to help you get your impacts (3 hits each).

TIPS for the qualifier:

- *Have the right gear- a scope capable of dialing or holding for the long shots and an accurate rifle; 223 or larger with a bipod or shooting bags.
- *Ensure your rifle is zeroed for your ammo (recommend match) and ready to perform.
- *Know your ballistic data/your holds for the different ranges.
